This Indenture, Made this 10th day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty five between George Stuart and Francis Stuart his wife in the County of Franklin and State of Ohio of the first part, and W. W. Jenkins and F. C. Jenkins his wife of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of twenty two hundred (\$2200⁰⁰) Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South East Quarter (1/4) of Section No Thirty one (31) in Township No Twelve (12) South of Range No Twenty two (22) East of the 6th principal Meridian with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said George and Francis C. Stuart his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.
