Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Thirty and fifty five hundredths (\$30.55) Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have parted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described piece and parcel of land being and situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit, Lot No seven (7) in Block No seventeen (17) of Lawrence Addition to the city of Lawrence.

To have and to hold the same, with all and singular the appurtenances and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the party of the second part and to his heirs & assigns forever. And the said John T. Grason and Verline Grason do hereby covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, & seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all encumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession
