This Indenture Made this third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighty Eight (1888) between Henry E. Benson single¹ of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Caroline Levy by Alex Marks in Trust of Albany in the County of and State of New York of the second part:

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Lot Number Seventy five (75) Vermont Street, in the City of Lawrence County and State aforesaid with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars according to the terms of a certain promissory coupon note dated July 5th 1888. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in said payment, or any part thereof, as provided then this conveyance shall become absolute, and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to enter the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all
