Thomas White of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of six hundred eighty three $\frac{3}{4}$ Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: the North forty $\frac{1}{2}$ feet of Lot number Twenty-two (22) in Block Five (5) of Lane's first Addition to the City of Lawrence according to the plat thereof with the boundaries and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part herein and the said John W. Beard and Annie W. Beard do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of six hundred eighty three $\frac{3}{4}$ Dollars with interest thereon at the rate of eight percent per annum from date until paid according to the terms of a certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said John W. Beard to the said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as aforesaid specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part hereof, or interest thereon, or if taxes, or life insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become a bond, and the same shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time hereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part hereof, in the manner prescribed by law, if payment hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand, to the said John W. Beard and Annie W. Beard.
