Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Forty seven and $\frac{10}{100}$ Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas to wit:

Lot number fifteen (15) in Block Two Hundred & seven (217) in the City of Endora according to the plat of said city to have and to hold the same together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.
