Whereas, Emma S. Cummings ^{Wm} William J. Cummings, her husband of the County of Douglas State of Kansas executed and delivered to Timothy B. Sweet, Trustee, a deed of Trust bearing date the 2nd day of July A.D. 1855 conveying to him in trust, for the purposes therein set forth, the following described premises, situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit: The Northwest quarter of Section No. Fourteen (14) Also a part of the E^{1/2} of Section No. Fifteen (15) described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section No. Fifteen (15) thence North $15^{\circ} 55'$ chains thence west Thirteen and $\frac{1}{2}$ (13 $\frac{1}{2}$) chains thence South $1^{\circ} 55'$ chains to center of old Territorial Road, thence South Twenty Nine (29) Degrees East down said road to South line of said quarter section, thence East to beginning. Also beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section No. Fifteen (15) thence West to intersect with said Territorial road thence South Twenty Nine (29) Degrees East to East line of said quarter section in center of said road Twenty and $\frac{3}{4}$ (20 $\frac{3}{4}$) chains South of said Northeast corner, thence North Twenty One (21) chains to beginning.
