

second part or his assigns, to bear any time thereafter exercised without notice to the parties of the first part, but the legal holder of this mortgage may at option pay or cause to be paid the said taxes and assessments so due and payable, and such premium and charges for insurance, as the mortgagor or assigns shall neglect or refuse to pay, and charge them against said parties of the first part, and the amounts so charged shall be an additional upon the said mortgaged property, and may be enforced and collected in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured, together with interest at the rate of twelve per cent, per annum, payable annually, until fully paid and discharged; but whether the party of the second part elect to pay such taxes, assessments and insurance or not, it is distinctly understood that in all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated, then, in like manner, the said note and the whole of the said sum shall immediately become due and payable, and the said mortgagor or his assigns may immediately cause this mortgage to be foreclosed, and shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises and thereto, issues and profits thereof. And the said parties of the first part shall and will at their own expense, from this time until said notes and interest, and all liens and charges by virtue hereof, are fully paid of and discharged, keep the buildings erected and to be erected on said lands insured to the amount of thirty-five hundred dollars to the satisfaction of the mortgagor or his assigns, in some Insurance Company duly authorized to do business in this State, for the benefit of the party of the second part, and his assigns, who shall have possession of all the policies of insurance and all renewal receipts thereof. And the said parties of the first part hereby waive all benefits of the day, valuation or appraisement laws of the State of Kansas.
