Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in  
consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, to them  
duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have  
sold and by these presents do grant, Bargain, sell and  
mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs  
a signs forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated  
in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as  
follows, to-wit: The East half (½) of the West half (½) of the West  
quarter (¼) of the North East quarter (¼) of the South East quarter
