

12 per cent. per annum, computed annually on said principal note from date thereof to the time when the money shall be actually paid, and any payment made on account of interest shall be credited in said computation, so that the total amount of interest collected shall be, and not exceed, the legal rate of 12 per cent.; but the party of the second part may pay any unpaid taxes charged against said property, or insure said property if default be made in keeping up insurance, and may recover for all such payments with interest at twelve per cent., in any suit for foreclosure of this mortgage; and it shall be lawful for the party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time hereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; Abatement waived or not, at the option of the party of the second part, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due, or to become due, according to the conditions of this instrument, and interest at twelve per cent. per annum from the time of said default until paid, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and a reasonable attorney's fee before the foreclosure of this mortgage, to be taxed as other costs in the suit.
