parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of fifteen
hundred dollars, to them duly paid, have sold, and by these pre-
sents do grant and convey to the said party, of the second part, and
its assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situated in said Douglas
County, and State of Kansas, and described as follows, to wit:

50 feet North & South in the North West corner of said Reserve also lies

Topeka Railway Company with the appurtenances and all the state,
