whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be
lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, ad-
ministrators and assigns at anytime thereafter, to sell the
premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner
prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the
option of the party of the second part her executors, adminis-
trators or assigns; and out of all the money arising from such
sale to retain the amount then due for principal & interest,
together with the cost and charge of making such sales, and
the surplus if any there be shall be paid by the party making
such sale or demand, to the said parties of the first part heirs
and assigns.
