This instrument made the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight by and between William Morrison and Martha J. Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part do and in consideration of the sum of five thousand six hundred Dollars to them in hand, paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted Bargained and sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, all of the following described tract, pieces or parcels of land lying and situated in the Counties of Leavenworth & Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

The North East Quarter of the South Half of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty One 1/4; Also the South East Quarter of Section Twenty Eight 5/8 all in Township Ten 10 Range Twenty One 1/4 East 96^{ft}

Also the East Thirtieth Sixty 60^{ft} acres of the South Half of the South East Quarter and the South Nine 87 acres of the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Sixteen 16 in Township Fifteen 15 Range Twenty 20 East of the 6th R. M. in Douglas Co excepting so much of the last named tract of 5 acres as is comprised in, or included in the Right of Way of the L. S. & K. R. R.

It is agreed and is to hold the same, with all and singular the hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of ownership exemption, until the said party of the second part, and its successors and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant & agree, that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and are of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
