and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the  
said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns forever, all  
the following described pieces and parcels of land lying & situate  
in the City of Lawrence County, of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot No. One hundred and Twenty two (122) One hundred & Twenty  
four (124) and One hundred and Twenty six (126) on Missouri Street in  
Block No. Forty two (42) in that part of the City of Lawrence known as  
West Lawrence according to the plat thereon file in the office of the  
Clerk of the District Court in and for Douglas Co. Ks.

Have and do hold the same, with all and singular the heredit-  
aments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the party  
of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said  
parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree, that at the de-  
livery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above grant-  
ed, and seized of a good and indisputable estate of inheritance therein  
free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant  
and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of  
said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, against  
all persons lawfully claiming the same.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express con-  
dition, that whereas, the said Parties of the first part are justly  
indebted unto the said Mary J. Smith in the principal sum of  
One hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States of America,  
being for a loan thereof on the day and date hereof, made by the  
said Mary J. Smith to the said parties of the first part and secured  
to be paid by the certain promissory note of the said parties of the  
first part bearing even date herewith, payable to the order of the said  
Mary J. Smith in two years from the date thereof, at office of Wm. D. Sinclair  
Lawrence, with interest after maturity, or default in payment  
of interest, at the rate of twelve per cent per annum until the  
said principal sum is fully paid. The interest on said note from  
date to maturity or default is to be paid semi-annually, on the  
15th day of April and of October in each and every year, as is specified  
by four interest notes or coupons of even date herewith, attached  
and by said promissory note it is agreed that if default be made  
in the payment of any interest coupon at maturity, then the  
said principal sum of One hundred Dollars with all the interest  
thereon, shall immediately become due and payable.
