This Indenture, Made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November A.D. 1887 between J. H. Davis and Emma Danis his wife of Douglas County in the State of Kansas of the first part, and Adelia A. Davis of Douglas County in the State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars and 00 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, and her heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas aforesaid:

The Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-eight, Township number Thirteen (13) Range Twenty One (21)

I have and to hold the same, together with all land, singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:

Provided always, and these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said parties of the first part have this day executed and delivered certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a correct copy

Stephens Nov. 21, 1887

On or before November 21, 1897, we promise to pay to Adelia A. Davis, One Thousand Dollars with interest at the rate of seven and one-half per cent per annum from date until paid, interest payable annually, value received.

Now, if said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, or her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon is not paid, when the same is due, and the taxes <sup>and</sup> assessments
