The Indenture Made this twentieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight, between J. C. Lawrence and Ella M. Lawrence husband and wife being of lawful age, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward Russell, of Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid, there receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcels of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Begin at a point 383 feet North of a point S 58° E 126 feet from the North West corner of the North West Quarter of Section Two (2) in Township Twelve (12) South of Range Eighteen (18) East and running thence East 766 feet, thence North 383 feet thence West 766 feet thence South 383 feet to the place of beginning, covering the North half of Blocks No. 32 and 33 vacated portion of City of Leavenworth. Also begins S 58° E 126 feet from the North West corner of the North West Quarter of Section Two (2) Township Twelve (12) South of Range Eighteen (18) East, thence South 766 feet, thence East 766 feet, thence North 766 feet, thence West 766 feet to the place of beginning, covering Blocks 32 and 33 vacated portion of City of Leavenworth and being in all about nineteen acres more or less.
