

This Indenture, Made this First day of November in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
eighty Eight

Witnesseth, that Isaac Hemphill & Rebecca L.  
Hemphill his wife of the county of Douglas and State  
of Kansas, party of the first part, for and in considera-  
tion of Two Hundred Dollars, conveys and Warrants to  
Henry Dickinson, party of the second part, his heirs  
and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described situate  
in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at the South West corner of the North  
East quarter of Section number Twenty (20) Township num-  
ber Fourteen (14) South of Range number Twenty (20)  
thence North One Hundred & Sixty (160) rods thence East  
Sixty Six (66) rods thence South Eighty One (81) rods thence  
West Forty three (43) rods thence South Seventy Nine  
(79) rods thence West Twenty Three (23) rods to place of  
beginning all lying East of the Fifth P.M. & containing  
Forty Three (43) acres more or less

To secure the said party of the second part for an actual  
loan of money made to the said Isaac Hemphill &  
Rebecca L. Hemphill as evidenced by one certain Bond  
to sixteen thousand seven hundred & two of Two Hun-  
dred Dollars of even date herewith in and by which said  
bond the party of the first part promise to pay to the  
order of Henry Dickinson in lawful money of the United  
States of America the principal sum of Two Hundred  
Dollars five years after date thereof, with interest there-  
on at the rate of Eight per centum per annum, interest  
payable semi annually, according to and upon presenta-  
tion of interest coupons therefor therunto attached, both principal  
and interest being payable at the National Bank of Commerce,  
in New York City. Also Providing, that in case any interest  
on any of said sums shall remain unpaid for ten days  
after the same becomes due, then the entire sums covered  
by said bond and secured by this Mortgage Deed, to become  
immediately due and payable, without any notice of  
any kind whatsoever, and same to be collected in like  
manner as if the full time provided in said bond had  
expired.
