

This Indenture, Made this 14 day of December 1888 between S. J. Counts & Mary A. Counts his wife of the first part, and C. E. Jewell of the second part:
 Witnesseth, That the part of the first part in consideration of \$126⁰⁰ does hereby sell and convey to said party of second part his heirs and assigns the following described real estate in Douglas County, Kansas:

The South East quarter (S 6 1/4) of the South West quarter (S 30 1/4) of Section Twenty six (26) Township Fourteen (14) Range Twenty (20). Also Beginning at the South west corner of the East half (1/2) of the West half (1/2) of the south west quarter (S 30 1/4) of Section Twenty six (26) Township Fourteen (14) Range Twenty (20) Thence East Thirty five (35) Rods Thence North Thirty (30) Rods. Thence West about Thirty five (35) Rods Thence South Thirty four (34) Rods to the place of beginning containing Forty seven (47) acres more or less
 The party of the first part warrant the title to said premises to said grantee his heirs and assigns forever; that the same free from all incumbrances and that they are now the owner thereof Except a Mtg of \$400 dated Jan 1st 87 payable to Edward Russell Lawrence

Provided Always, That if the said parties of the first part shall cause to be paid unto the said C. E. Jewell or his heirs or assigns one promissory note as follows

Baldwin City Kans Dec 14 1888

On or before one year after date we promise to pay to the order of C. E. Jewell One hundred twenty six⁰⁰ Dollars at the office of C. E. Jewell & Co Esqrs Value received with interest at 8 per cent per annum after date Appraisement raised

Then this instrument shall be void. But if any of said notes or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, or the taxes and assessments levied against said premises are not paid when due, then all said notes and interest thereon, shall and do become immediately due and payable. Appraisement raised.
