Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Grant ed, Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, all of the following-described land, lying and situated in Willow Springs Township, County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:
