Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described pieces and parcels of land lying and situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: Lots No. One Hundred and Ninety-seven (197) and One Hundred and Ninety-nine (199) on Elm Street, of Sub Division of Block No. Eleven (11), in that part of the City of Lawrence formerly known as North Lawrence To Have and to Hold the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, unto the party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever. And the said Parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will Warrant and Defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully claiming the same.
