Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between Mary E.
Larson, a widow, of Lawrence, Kansas of the first part and W. C.
Deardley, of Auburn New York, of the second part:

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to her in hand paid by the said party of
the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confecced and acknowledged,
 hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents doth
grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part,
 and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described piece
 and parcel of land lying and situate in the County of Douglas and
State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot No One Hundred and Forty three (143) on Connecticut Street in
the City of Lawrence, Kansas and to hold the same, with all and singular the
hereditaments and appurtenances there unto belonging, unto the party of
the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Mary
E. Larson doth hereby covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof she
is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good
