This indenture, made this first day of February in the year four thousand
thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between R. L. Johnston and
Selena A. Johnston, husband and wife, being of lawful age, of the County of
Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward Russell of
Lawrence Kansas, of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the
sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part as owners and
seignors forever the following tract or parcel of land situated in the
County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The South East Quarter of Section Twenty nine and one fourth
of Township 13 of Range Twenty one (21)

Grantors herein reserve the right to pay One Hundred and Fifty
(\$150.00) Dollars or any multiple thereof on the principal of the note
hereby secured, on January 1st 1891 or at the maturity of any interest
coupon thereafter by giving thirty days notice of such payment will
the aforesaid parties and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties
of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby con-
tract and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of
the premises above granted, and seized of a good and undivided estate
of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, that they
have good right to sell and convey said premises, and that they will
warrant and defend the same against the lawful claim of all persons.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum
of Fifteen Hundred Dollars and interest thereon, according to the terms of
two certain mortgage notes and 20 interest notes or coupons, this day ex-
ecuted by the said parties of the first part to wit:
