Witnesseth, That the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follow, to wit: The South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section One (1) in Township Twelve (12) of Range Nineteen (19), with the appurtenances and all the estate, little and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances; that she has good right to sell and convey said premises, and that she will Warrant and Defend the same against the lawful claim of all persons.
