Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100⁰⁰) and no Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit:

The West one half of the North East one fourth of the North East Quarter of Section No. Thirty six (36) Township No. Eleven (11) Range No. Seventeen (17)

To Have and to Hold the same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever. Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said Mary A. Bare and David Bare her husband have this day executed and delivered two certain promissory notes in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following are copies:

One year after date we promise to pay to O. D. Spencer Fifty dollars at Accidence with interest at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from date until paid value received
