Provided Always And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said and W. A. Boicourt have executed and delivered a certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a description.

Dated Apr 1st 1857. Payable One Day after date at the Baldwin City Bank with interest at 12% from date if not paid when due.

Now I said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum and sums of money, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
