The Indenture Made this Eleventh day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between Pryor W. Wallace and Martha A. Wallace his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Guy Bennett of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit: Lots Numbers One (1) and Two (2) in the North East fractional Quarter of Section Number Three (3) in Township Number Twelve (12) of Range Number Nineteen (19) with the all tenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Pryor W. Wallace and Martha A. Wallace do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of good and indefeasible estate of inheritance herein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatever. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred and fifty Dollars, according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said Pryor W. Wallace & Martha A. Wallace to the said party of the second part, said note being given for the sum of Three hundred and fifty (\$350.00) Dollars dated April 11th, 1887 due and payable in five years from the date thereof, with interest thereon from the date thereof unpaid, according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached.
