This Indenture Made this 11th day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between Charles H. Tucker and Jessie M. Tucker, his wife, of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Home Building and Loan Association of the City of Lawrence, said County of Douglas, of the second part, Witnesseth that the parties of the first, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to them duly paid have sold, and by these presents do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, and its assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situated in said Douglas County, and State of Kansas, and described as follows to-wit:

Lot No. Forty-six (146) on Louisiana Street, in the City of Lawrence, subject to mortgage of One Thousand Dollars to said Home Building and Loan Association with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the parties of the first part therein.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment and the full performance of all the obligations and conditions of a certain Bond this day executed by the said Charles H. Tucker to the said Home Building and Loan Association for the payment of \$200. as therein provided; and upon the full and prompt performance of all said conditions of said bond by the said party signing the same, this conveyance shall be void. But if default be made in the performance of any of the conditions of said bond, or in the making of any payment therein provided when the same shall be due; or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are assessed or levied against said premises are not paid at the time when the same are by law made due and payable, then, upon the happening of any of said failures, the whole of the said sum of \$200. together with such fines and penalties as shall accrue, under the By Laws of said Association, shall
