

Whereas, Ezekiel L. Clark and Marovia M. Clark of the County of Franklin State of Kansas executed and delivered to Timothy B. Sweet, Trustee, a Deed of Trust, bearing date the first day of March A.D. 1854 conveying to him in trust, for the purposes therein set forth, the following described premises, situated in the County of Franklin and State of Kansas to-wit:

The East half of the North east quarter of Sec No. Twenty (20) in Township No. Fifteen (15) South of Range No. Eighteen (18) East of 6<sup>th</sup> R.M. containing Eighty (80) Acres more or less. Also, the following described premises situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit: The South half of the South west quarter of Sec Sixteen (16) South of Range 18 East of 6<sup>th</sup> R.M. containing Eighty (80) Acres more or less a record of which said Deed of Trust appears in volume N of Mat page 105, in the records of the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the County last aforesaid. And, whereas, the conditions of said Trust Deed have been fulfilled, and said deed has, by virtue thereof become fully satisfied, by payment in full of the note secured by this Trust Deed.

Now, therefore, We, Timothy B. Sweet, Trustee, under said Deed and E. M. Sheldon holder and present owner of the promissory note secured thereby as Assignee in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to us in hand paid before the delivery hereof, do hereby grant, convey, release, and forever quit claim to the said Ezekiel L. Clark & Marovia M. Clark their heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in or to the premises aforesaid in us vested by virtue of said Trust Deed.
