This Indenture, Made this Twentieth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between Byron Lawyer and Medoria J. Lawyer of Clinton in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and A. E. Blatto of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and Twelve Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows: to wit: North half $\frac{1}{2}$ of South West quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty four $\frac{1}{4}$ Township Thirteen $\frac{1}{2}$ Range Eighteen $\frac{1}{2}$ East of 5th P.M. in Douglas Co. Kansas with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Byron Lawyer and Medoria J. Lawyer do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four hundred and Twelve Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said Byron Lawyer & Medoria J. Lawyer to the said party of the second part, said note being given for the sum of Four hundred and Twelve Dollars, dated May Twentieth 1889 due and payable in five years from date thereof with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as in said note and coupons thereto.
