This Indenture Made this 29th day of May A.D. 1879 between D. K. Lawrence of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and Henry Deiter of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the second part.

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of six hundred (\$600.00) Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit: The North half (1/2) of the South East quarter (1/4) of Section No. Twenty-three (23) Township No. Twelve Range No. Seventeen (17)

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise pertaining forever.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said D. K. Lawrence has this day executed and delivered three certain promissory notes in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following are copies: 1. Big Springs Kas. May 29th 1879 One year after date I promise

to pay to the order of Henry Deiter Two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars at his residence value received with interest at 5 per cent per annum after date until paid.

2. Big Springs Kas. May 29th 1879 Two years after date I promise to pay to the order of Henry Deiter Two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars at his residence value received

with interest at 5 per cent per annum after date until paid. 3. Big Springs Kas. May 29th 1879 Three years after date I promise to pay to the order of Henry Deiter Two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars at his residence value received with interest at 5 per cent per annum after date until paid.

Now, if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise, shall remain in full force and effect.
