This Indenture Made this 29<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between William Bromelick and Louisa Bromelick his wife of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and the Home Building and Loan Association of the city of Lawrence in said County of Douglas, of the second part, Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part for consideration of the sum of Twenty four Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid by the said William Bromelick, and by the receipt of the same, do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, and its assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situated in said Douglas County, and State of Kansas, and described as follows, to wit: Lots No's forty nine and Eighty one (1) on Rhode Island Street, in the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances; and all the estate, title and interest of the parties of the first part therein.
