

Sixty one (61) on Kentucky Street in the City of Lawrence according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining forever.

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas The Alliance Trust Company has this day executed and delivered to certain promissory notes in writing to said party, of the second part of which the following is a description.

Fifteen hundred Dollars on or before on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1890.

Fifteen hundred Dollars on or before on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1891

Fifteen hundred Dollars on or before on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1892

Fifteen hundred Dollars on or before on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1894 all bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum payable semi-annually. It is further agreed that on the payment of Twenty-two hundred Dollars at any time to said party, the 574 N's of Sixty one Lawrence is to be released.

Now if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void, and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are, or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
