Gifford of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has sold, and by these presents does, sell, assign, and convey unto the said party of the second part, all his right, title and interest in and to a certain indenture of mortgage bearing date the 8th day of February in the year 1887 made by Christian Long in favor of A.J.
