This Indenture Made this Thirty first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between Julia N. Hofstad and Martin Hofstad wife and husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part and Evan Davis of the second part.

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and Fifty Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:

Lots Nos One (1) and Two (2) in Block No Twelve (12) of Lane Place in the City of Lawrence Douglas Co. Kansas with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

And the said Parties of first Part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they the lawful owners of the premises above granted will seize of a good and indefensible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever excepting one Mortgage for Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred and Fifty Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said Parties of the first part to the said party of the second part. Said note being given for the sum of Three hundred and Fifty Dollars dated Aug 31st 1889 due and payable in Eighteen Months from the date thereof with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached. And
