

I now all men by these presents, That the Board of Church Extension of the Methodist Episcopal Church, a corporation under the laws of Pennsylvania, does hereby certify, that a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1856 and made and executed by J. Holloway, J. H. Gleason, J. M. Price, J. P. Hammond, M. Hale, A. M. Ellisor & D.
