This Indenture, Made this Fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, between Ruth Benson and A. St. Benson her husband of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and George W. Bell of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One hundred (100⁰⁰) Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, in one sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point Twenty (20) rods East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Township Number One South, Range Twenty (20) East of the 4th P.M. line, thence North Twenty (20) rods, thence East Four (4) rods, thence South Twenty (20) rods, thence East Four (4) rods to the place of beginning, containing One half (1/2) acre being in that part of the City of Lawrence, known as North Lawrence, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Ruth Benson and A. St. Benson do hereby covenant and agree that the delivery hereof shall be the lawful owner(s) of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefensible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances except a Mortgage of three hundred (300) Dollars given by Jacob W. Miller & Wife to the National Scan and Trust Company due March 1st 1892.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred Dollars (100⁰⁰),

according to the terms of one certain promissory Note this day executed and delivered by the said Ruth Benson and A. St. Benson to the said party of the second part: payable one year after date with interest at 10 percent payable semi-annually, from date until paid. Payable at the office of the National Scan and Trust Company, Lawrence, Kansas.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Ruth Benson and A. St. Benson her heirs and assigns.
