This Indenture, Made this first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight between William A. Pardee and A. D. Pardee his wife of Willow Springs, Mo., in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and J. C. Howard of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One thousand and thirty and 7/10 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the North East corner of the North East quarter of Section Number 14 Township 14 Range 16 from thence running South One hundred rods to the West Party Line rod distance 100 rods to the South West corner of Section 14 Township 14 Range 16 thence North 100 rods to the North East corner of Section 14 Township 14 Range 16 to place of beginning containing Point 60 acres of land more or less in the North East quarter of Section 14 Township 14 Range 16 in Douglas County containing Point 60 acres of land making in all Eighty acres and hereinafter called with all the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said William A. Pardee and A. D. Pardee his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand and thirty dollars and Seventy-two cents with interest thereon payable annually according to the terms of certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said William A. Pardee and A. D. Pardee to the said party of the second part for the sum of One thousand and thirty dollars and seventy-two cents payable annually with interest thereon from the time of the execution of this instrument and to run ten percent interest on the sum so becoming due and payable A. D. Pardee and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said William A. Pardee and A. D. Pardee his wife their heirs and assigns.
