

This Indenture, Made this 21 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between
H. C. Jay and Eliza Jay his wife
of Galena in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,
of the first part, and W. C. Howard
of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said partie of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Nine and $\frac{60}{100}$ Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said partie of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit The South West Quarter of Section Number Twenty Nine (29) in Township number Fourteen (14) of Range number Twenty Six (26) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian. Excepting therefrom so much of said parcel of land as has heretofore been taken and appropriated by the Government, and Galveston Rail Road Company as a right of way for their Rail Roads the same is now to be used and occupied by the said Rail Road Company or as it may have the right under any former party's condemnation to receive or occupy the same and to surrender the same to the said Rail Road Company or as it may have the right under any former party's condemnation to receive or occupy the same with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said partie of the first part therein. And the said H. C. Jay and Eliza Jay his wife
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Hundred and Nine and $\frac{60}{100}$ Dollars with $\frac{12}{100}$ cent interest from the 22nd of 1889 until paid according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said H. C. Jay and Eliza Jay to the said partie of the second part; in note reads as following: 10th of Baldwin Lane March 22nd 1889 the Month before sale or either if previously paid the order of W. C. Howard One hundred and Nine and $\frac{60}{100}$ Dollars value received with interest thereon from date until paid 10th of May 1890 and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said partie of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the partie of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the partie making such sale on demand to the said H. C. Jay and Eliza Jay his wife their heirs and assigns.
