

MORTGAGE RECORD

This Indenture, Made this Fourth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine, between John B. Russell and Flora B. Russell his wife of the City of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hugh Blair of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS, to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit All that part of the South East quarter of section number Fourteen, in Township Thirteen (13) Range Nineteen (19) lying North of the Arkansas River and except three acres of the South West corner thereof known as Mary White and Reeser in Deed of First September 1880 made by George White and Mary White to said John B. Russell also all that certain other parcel or lots of land and premises composed of all that part of the North East quarter of section Twenty Three in Township Thirteen (13) Range Nineteen (19) lying North of the Arkansas River containing about 16 acres more or less the two parcels being conterminous with the same and bounded on the South by the same and on the West by the same and on the East by the same and on the North by the same and all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said

John B. Russell and Flora B. Russell do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances, save and except a certain Mortgage of \$2500, dated April 1, 1886 to Edward Russell and assigned by him to Nathaniel Myrick

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand dollars

according to the terms of a certain Deed of mortgage this day executed and delivered by the said John B. Russell and Flora B. Russell to the said party of the second part: payable one year after date with interest at 8% from date until maturity and thereafter annually until paid

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, of any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the second part making such sale on demand to the said party of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
