

THE FOG, BIRKBECK HALL, LIVERPOOL, ENGLAND.

This Indenture, Made this 10th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine, between Achilles B. Wade and Nancy C. Wade his wife, of Douglas, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and D. J. Hayes of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of
Twenty four Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State
of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit Beginning at the North West corner of the North East quarter
of Section No 116 in Township No Thirteen & Range No Twenty (20) East, thence
South on West line of said lot, 16 chains 5 links, thence East parallel with North line
said lot, 16 chains 5 links, thence at right angle North 15 chains 5 links to North line
said lot, thence West on said North line 16 chains 5 links to beginning, containing 15
acres, and being the home lead of first parties, who agree to maintain during the ex-
istence of this mortgage, insurance of \$1,500.00 on said property, for benefit of mortgagee,
and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party, his
heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully claiming the same
with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
parties of the first part
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized
of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant
and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party, his
heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully claiming the same

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty four hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part, due in three years from date, without interest after maturity or default, at the rate of ten per cent per annum, the interest from date to maturity being as intended by coupons attached to said note.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said party of the first part their heirs and assigns.
