Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part two heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The entire land and the fourth west quarter of the north east quarter of section twenty (20) in Bronelip Township (14) of Rangeline (15) part of the 61 C.M. containing one hundred and twenty (120) acres more or less.

of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty five thousand dollars according to the terms of a Provisionary note this day executed and delivered by the said George W. Reynolds & M. F. Reynolds to the said party of the second part: said note being for Twenty five thousand dollars, dated March first 1850 at $\frac{7}{10}$ per annum, or before six years from the date.
