Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas to wit:

To situate Nine (9) and Ten (10) in Block One hundred and eighty (180) in the the City of Eudora, according to the plat of said City.

This mortgage is given subject to another mortgage given by the same parties to Charles Durr for \$275.

To have and to hold the same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that where as said Anna L. Gether and William J. Gether have this day executed and delivered a certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy:

Eudora Kansas Sept. 5th 1889.

Three years after date (without grace) we promise to pay to the order of Catherine Ott, Two Hundred Dollars, for value received with
