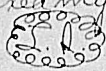

This Indenture, Made this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighty Nine between J. L. Crew and Josephine L. Crew husband and Wife in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and The Western Farm Mortgage Trust Company of Lawrence Kansas, of the second part:

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part, its representatives or assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit: The North half of Lot Fifty (50) on Vermont Street in the City of Lawrence Kansas. Do have and to hold the same, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein forever.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars, according to the terms of One note of even date herewith, this day executed and delivered by the said party of the first part to the said party of the second part, payable at its office in Lawrence Kansas, as follows, to wit:
