This Indenture, Made this Twentieth day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and Ninety, between Emma Lohr and Samuel A. Lohr her husband of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Mary J. Lewis of New York of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit: Lot number One hundred and eighty eight (188) on Tennessee Street in the City of Lawrence according to the plat on file in the Registry office for said County, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Emma L. Lohr and Samuel A. Lohr do
