Witnesseth, that Thomas H. Monroe, Edward Black and Andrew Monroe as Trustees of the African Methodist Episcopal Church of Eudora Kansas of the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, for and in consideration of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars convey and Warrant to Henry Dickinson party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described, situate in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas to-wit: Lot number Three (3) in Block number Two hundred and Seven (207) in the City of Eudora Douglas County State of Kansas
