is Indenture Made this 14th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety between Mary E. Simpson, a widow of the City of Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Kansas National Building and Loan Association of Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part, Witnesseth, that the party of the first part, for consideration of the sum of Four hundred Dollars, to her duly paid, hath sold, and by these presents doth grant and convey to the said party of the second part, and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the North East corner of Lot No. Twelve (12) in Block No. Four (4) of Babcock's Addition to the City of Lawrence, and running thence West on the North line of said Lot No. 12, 250 feet, thence North 50 feet, thence East parallel with the North line of said Lot No. 12, 250 feet, thence South 50 feet to place of beginning with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the party of the first part therein; and the said Mary E. Simpson doth hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free
