 promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the fol-
 lowing is a copy. Two years after date for value received I promise to pay to
 the order of Emma L. Harris Five Hundred and Sixty Seven dollars and twenty
 four cents with interest from date at the rate of seven per cent per annum
 interest payable annually.

Now, If said party of the first shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the
 second part, her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note
 mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor
 of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and other-
 wise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money,
 or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due,
 and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and
 levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are
 by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest
 thereon, shall, and by these presents, become due and payable, and said party
 of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
