 of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to  
 become due according to the conditions of this instrument, together with the  
 costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall  
 be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said Lauren M.  
 Todd his heirs and assigns.
