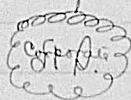


Whereas, John L. Haskell and Mary E. B. And, whereas, the conditions of said Trust Deed have been fulfilled, and said Deed has become fully satisfied, and the note of \$1300 secured thereby has been paid.

Now, Therefore, The Kansas Loan Trust Company, Trustee under said Deed, and E. M. Sheldon holder and present legal owner of the promise or note secured thereby, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar, to us in hand paid before the delivery hereof, do hereby release and forever quit claim to the said John L. Haskell and Mary E. B. Haskell their heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in or to the premises aforesaid in us vested by virtue of said Trust Deed.
