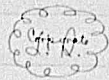

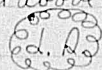

Piper and Mattie Piper, husband and wife (being of lawful age) of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward Russell Lawrence, Kansas of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tracts or parcels of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: The East half of the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section No. Twenty one (21) and the South West quarter of the South West Quarter of Section No. Twenty eight (28) both in Township No. Twelve (12) of Range No. Nineteen (19) Grantors herein reserve the right to pay One hundred Dollars or any multiple thereof on the principal of the note hereby secured on April 1st 1892 or at maturity of any interest coupon thereafter by paying thirty days interest in excess of that then due and accrued with the appurtenances and
