Grant her husband of the City of Lawrence County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and the Kansas National Building and Loan Association of Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part, Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars Dollars, to them duly paid, have sold, and by these presents do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and described as follows to wit: Lot No Fifty two (52) on Louisiana Street, in the City of Lawrence; subject to prior mortgage of \$500. to said party of the second part, with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the parties of the first part therein, and the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, and assigns forever.
